

Bremer Canyon Killer Whale Expedition

January to March

Join our expedition team for an unforgettable experience as we traverse the remote Southern Ocean to the Bremer Canyon, the only place in Australia you can regularly encounter Killer Whales in the wild.

Over 100 Killer Whales return to this location each year. During the season we encounter these apex predators engaging in a variety of activities, from hunting to socialising. Experience an incredible sense of privilege when the Killer Whales choose to approach our expedition vessel, as curious about you as you are about them!

Bremer Canyon Expeditions

The offshore marine environment of the Bremer Canyon supports an incredible diversity of life. As well as encountering Killer Whales over 95% of the time, other wildlife commonly seen are: Bottlenose, Striped, and Common Dolphins, Long-Finned Pilot Whales, Sperm Whales, Hammerhead, Blue and Whaler Sharks, Australian Sea Lions, New Zealand Fur Seals, Giant Squid, Oceanic Sunfish. Even the rare Beaked Whale. Plus an astonishing array of pelagic seabirds including Albatross, Shearwater and Petrel species. Experience a place like no other in the world.

Bremer Canyon Sperm Whale and Pelagic Expedition

April to May

Join the team for an incredible offshore odyssey to see the iconic giant of the deep - the magnificent Sperm Whale. The unique deep-water ecosystem of the Bremer Canyon is the only place in Australia you can see Sperm Whales in the wild.

Your expedition may also encounter Killer Whales and Long-Finned Pilot Whales, as well as the largest animal to have ever existed, the Blue Whale. Pods of Bottlenose, Common, and Striped Dolphins regularly provide spectacular acrobatic displays, while an array of pelagic seabirds fill the air.
